

DUBLIN HIGH SCHOOL STUDENT DEVELOPS BUS TRACKING APP

LIVERMORE, CA, April 6, 2018 – Dublin High School (DHS) sophomore Liam O'Flynn has made it easier for Tri-Valley residents to track the progress of Wheels and Rapid buses on their smartphones. Liam wrote and published the "Tri-Valley Buses" app shortly after he began attending DHS and had missed the bus a couple of times.

The Livermore Amador Valley Transit Authority (LAVTA) already had a bus tracking application on its website, but it was not easily used on mobile devices. Liam was able to use LAVTA's General Transit Feed Specification (GTFS) Realtime data to develop his app. The same GTFS data from LAVTA and other US transit systems is used by Google maps for the transit service option on its mapping program.

The Tri-Valley Buses app is available for free download on iOS or Android devices. The app is designed to use very little data, battery or memory on mobile devices and does not track the user's activities in any way or contain any kind of advertising. The user selects which Wheels or Rapid route they want to track and a map displays every bus stop along the route along with the precise location of every bus on the route. When the bus icon is tapped, the app shows vehicle number, direction of travel and on-time status. (See screenshot on following page)
