RTD Introduces Care Connection Transportation to Healthcare Facilities

Reconnect with Health on RTD

Beginning Monday, April 2, San Joaquin Regional Transit District (RTD) will expand transportation options for passengers who require advanced, specialized healthcare—even beyond the borders of San Joaquin County. Care Connection is a new program that facilitates transportation from patients' own homes to their approved healthcare providers in Sacramento. In May, connection service will extend to medical facilities in the Greater San Francisco Bay Area.

With funding from the State Transit Assistance Fund, RTD has developed additional transportation options that connect passengers with services such as the Altamont Corridor Express (ACE) train and RTD's daily Commuter bus services to Sacramento and the Dublin BART station. The cost to eligible passengers who require transportation from their homes to these services is only \$3.00 for the first and last-mile connection, plus the cost of each long-distance transportation service. For example, the cost of a trip from a patient's home to a medical facility in Sacramento using RTD would total \$10.00 one-way — \$3.00 for the connection service and \$7.00 for the Commuter bus fare. Connections to Medivan, a Non-Emergency Medical Transportation service operated by Stanislaus Area Regional Transit (STaRT), will
