Bedford-to-Toledo Service

Bedford Service also has a twice daily (M-F) route to the Franklin Park Mall or the Miracle Mile shopping area (by request) in Toledo. From there, riders can transfer to the TARTA system, if needed. All the details are on our website – lakeerietransit.com.

Essential Transportation Services

Call-ahead door-to-door service is for seniors (60+ yrs.) and, if room is available, those in Bedford Township with disabilities that meet certain criteria. For more information, visit lakeerietransit.com or call 888-664-5984.

The ETS # 4 bus provides Bedford residents the ability to ride from Bedford to Monroe and vice versa. Please call to schedule your ride at least a day in advance.

8:45 – 9:00 AM

ETS # 4 picks up in the City of Monroe to transport senior passengers to South County destinations, including Bedford.

9:00 – 9:45 AM

ETS #4 drops off passengers from Monroe in Bedford, and picks up Bedford seniors going to Monroe.

10:30 – 11:00 AM

ETS # 4 arrives back in the City of Monroe.

1:45 – 2:15 PM

ETS # 4 picks up in the City of Monroe to transport senior passengers to South County destinations, including Bedford.

3:00 – 3:30 PM

ETS # 4 drops off in Bedford and picks up seniors wishing to go to the Monroe.

3:45 – 4:15 PM

ETS # 4 returns to Monroe and drops passengers. (There is no return trip until the following day.)

We have a few simple rules that make sure everyone has a pleasant, comfortable ride. And we appreciate your cooperation more than you know.

- No smoking. (It's the law.)
- No eating or drinking.
- No pets or animals on board (except service animals and other animals in proper containers).
- Electronic devices (radios/CD players) must use earphones.
- Limit carry-on packages to what you can carry on one trip.
