

## OVERVIEW:

Immediately following the Pulse tragedy, LYNX partnered with several public agencies to assist Central Florida. Public transportation plays such a heavy role in our community and LYNX, along with the City of Orlando, Orange County and countless other community partners rallied together to assist the needs of the community. Our agency responded with detours, temporary stops, signage, social media posts and more. We also staffed bilingual representatives at the family assistance center and provided 1,180 passenger trips to the vigil.

## TRANSPORTATION ASSISTANCE:

Requests immediately poured in for LYNX to aid Central Floridians and their families with transportation. Examples include a cooling bus for first responders shortly after the suspect was taken down, transporting nightclub patrons from Pulse to the Orlando Police Department Headquarters after the incident, transportation to and from area hotels, the family assistance centers and Orlando International Airport.

Seven LYNX buses provided transportation for President Obama's visit. ACCESSLYNX vehicles transported people from the hospital to the Amway Center to meet with the President. An additional bus transported surgeons from Orlando Regional Medical center to the Emergency Operations Center.

**DETOURS:**

LYNX operates four routes along Orange Avenue in the area of the Pulse Nightclub. Combined daily ridership of Links 7, 11, 18 and 40 is approximately 4,610 people per weekday. Detours were put into place shortly after the incident occurred. The city's Emergency Operations center was also staffed with LYNX personnel.

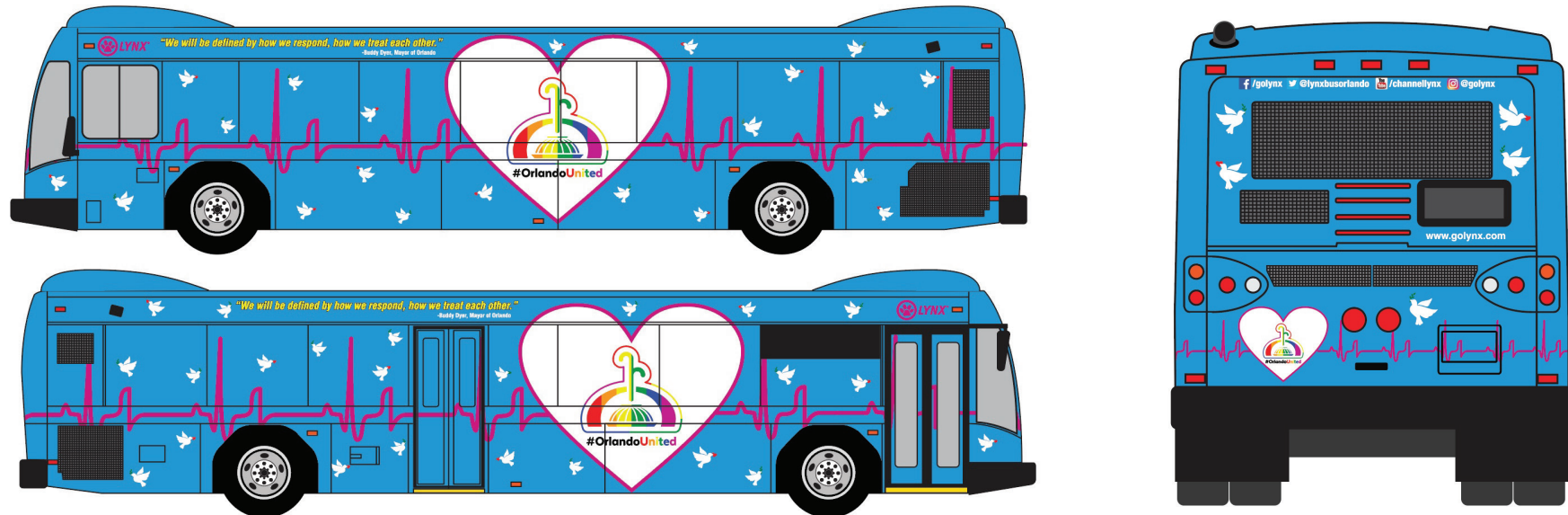





### PULSE VIGIL:

Several departments pulled together a transit plan to run shuttles for the vigil. As a result, we provided 1,180 passenger trips with a two-day turn around.

LYNX provided eight buses from three locations scattered throughout our service area to assist the community in attending the event. Orange County Public Schools partnered with LYNX to provide three additional buses. The Pulse Vigil held at Lake Eola in downtown Orlando drew more than 50,000 people.

### Lynx unveils new bus wrap commemorating Orlando shooting victims

On Thursday, Lynx unveiled a new bus wrap to commemorate the victims of the Pulse nightclub mass shooting in Orlando.

"We touch just about every aspect of this community, and we needed to show our support," said Lynx CEO Edward Johnson. "We wanted to come up with a way to show that we stand as part of the OneOrlando mindset."

The bus features Orlando's Lake Eola fountain surrounded by a heart, a pulse and 49 doves representing the 49 victims of the tragedy.

"We tried to think of a way not only to honor the victims, but also to bring Orlando together," said lead creative designer **Jessica Casa**. "It seemed like the perfect thing to have [the fountain] in the heart and have a pulse entering it — the pulse of the city of Orlando."

The bus wrap was produced rapidly. Once the design team began, it was only a matter of hours until they put the finishing touches on the final product. After that, the installation company stepped in. Although the print and installation process typically takes three to four days, employees worked through the night to get the bus ready as quickly as possible.

"We're all very proud of the final product," Johnson said.

Although the bus is not running any routes yet, Johnson hopes it will run along Orange Avenue as a tribute to where the shooting took place.

The bus will remain in the fleet for some time to come.

"We don't want to put any timetable on this because we know that this event is going to be with us for a while," said Johnson. "There are a lot of things we have to go through as far as the healing process."

The company's Boston-based advertising contractor, Direct Media USA, is donating a second commemorative bus due to arrive in the upcoming week.

"They understand OneOrlando [because] they understand Boston Strong," said **Matthew Friedman**, director of marketing communications for Lynx.

"My hope for this design is that it will help the community heal," Casa said. "It's a tough time, and we want people to know we're all in this together."

Lynx has also started an internal company website to collect money that will be donated to the OneOrlando fund.

"This was such a small token of what we could do to show our spirit as well as get the message out to our entire community: We are a unified Orlando," Johnson said.

### Lynx, SunRail, JetBlue, extend or shift service in wake of Pulse shooting

Lynx, SunRail and JetBlue either shifted or extended service to help Orlando city cope with the 12-block shut

The region's public transportation shifted to reach the needs of a city that's working around Sunday's mass-shooting site south of downtown.

Lynx public bus transit system shifted four routes — lines 7, 11, 18 and 40 — diverting more than a thousand people that usually ride through Orange Avenue to the adjacent Delaney Avenue between Michigan Street and Gore Street, about 1.3 miles.

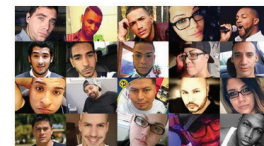
"We're going to continue to detour [these] routes ... as long as necessary," said Lynx CEO Edward L. Johnson.

"Lynx is proud to be part of this effort ... but ultimately we are providing support to the city of Orlando and following their direction," Johnson said.

SunRail offered extended service Monday night for the vigil at the Dr. Phillips Center for the Performing Arts.

JetBlue, which has thousands of flights to Puerto Rico from Orlando International Airport, offered free flights to victims' next of kin and domestic partners to Orlando. Ten of the victims from the mass shooting Sunday are reported to be from Puerto Rico.

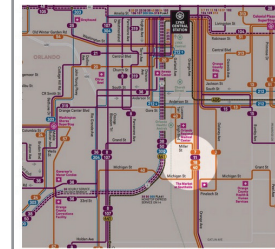

### Public Transit Keeps Orlando Moving Despite Tragedy

In the wake of the terrible shooting in Orlando, Florida on June 12, many people and organizations stepped up to help those affected by this tragedy. One of those organizations was the public bus service, Lynx.



Lynx is the regional public bus agency in Orlando, Florida. It provides fixed route bus service over a 3-county region (the area of which is larger than Delaware). The agency provides over 100,000 rides every weekday and made a record 301 million passenger trips in 2014.

The shooting at Pulse nightclub occurred at the southern edge of downtown on the main thoroughfare leading to the heart of downtown Orlando, the hospital, and the central bus station.

Immediately following the shooting, authorities shut down Orange Ave. — the main road that runs past Pulse Nightclub. In response to this, Lynx had to reroute four lines (7, 11, 18, 40 — area highlighted above) over a one and a half mile stretch of the Avenue and relocate 8 stops. This area generates a good number of trips for the agency. There are multiple shopping centers, restaurants, retail shops, a commuter rail station, and of course the hospital along the corridor.

In order to keep the city moving despite the tragedy, Lynx quickly assigned temporary stops and signage along the affected routes, which allowed their riders to access essential points like the hospital, doctor's office, and grocery stores.

The agency also took to social media to alert their riders of the closures, handed out leaflets, and reached out to traditional news outlets as well in order to share information about the detours and temporary stops.

Lynx also assisted with transportation to the Family Assistance Center (located temporarily at the football stadium) for the families of victims and provided free bus service to over 1,000 riders on June 19 for the vigil service.

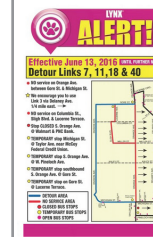

**Edward Johnson, CEO of LYNX** (and an alum of ENO's Transit Senior Executive Program) added, "LYNX's primary role is to ensure we move the citizens of Central Florida from their homes to places of employment, entertainment and so forth safely and efficiently. But, also we support the community in a time of need. While maintaining detoured routes along the affected corridor, our employees coordinated transportation support for the City of Orlando for families of the victims of this tragic event and coordinated a transportation solution to minimize traffic congestion in the city center for a candlelight vigil with more than 50,000 people in attendance."

Lynx was not the only transportation organization to step up however. The Florida Department of Transportation, which operates commuter rail service in the region, ran special SunRail service during the June 19th vigil and JetBlue has offered free flights to Orlando for relatives and partners of victims.

Public transportation — be it bus, rail, or plane — touches every aspect of a community. Lynx, SunRail, and JetBlue are a part of many people's lives every day. These organizations stepped up when they were needed most and demonstrated how critical their services are in times of crisis. Their timely and organized response helped many continue on despite this tragedy.

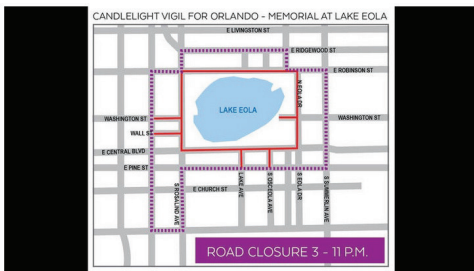

### 20K people expected to attend Sunday Lake Eola vigil for Pulse shooting victims

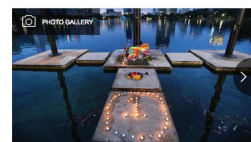
City officials are preparing for more than 20,000 people to attend a vigil for the victims of the Pulse shooting at Lake Eola Park Sunday evening.

The vigil, scheduled to begin at 7 p.m. Sunday, will be preceded by a memorial at the Cathedral Church of St. Luke at 6 p.m. It will be followed by a procession from there to the lakeside park.

City of Orlando spokeswoman Cassandra Lafser said the **Orlando Police Department** will patrol the memorial. But to for the safety of the attendees, she did not detail specifics of the security plan.

"OPD will be there to ensure the safety and security of everyone at the vigil," Lafser said. "They are aware and have appropriately allocated resources for this."

**SunRail** and LYNX have both made special accommodations to assist with transportation on Sunday.

The first SunRail train on Sunday will be southbound from the DeBary station at 5 p.m., and will make all stops on the way to the Sand Lake Road station. It will then return northbound from the Sand Lake Road station, making all stops to DeBary.

There are five round-trip trains total, with the last southbound train leaving DeBary at 10 p.m. and then making a return northbound trip at 11:15 p.m. from the Sand Lake Road station, according to Governor **Rick Scott's** office said. Regular

SunRail fares will apply. [Click here](#) for the complete schedule.

LYNX will provide complimentary bus transportation to the vigil from Valencia College's east campus on Eonlockhatchee Trail, the West Oaks Mall in Ocoee and the parking garage at the Osceola County administration building in Kissimmee. [Click here](#) for more information.

Several roads around Lake Eola will be closed from 3-11 p.m. Sunday. City officials announced that the portions of North Eola Drive, East Robinson Street, South Rosalind Avenue, Wall Street, Washington Street and East Central Boulevard that surround the lake will be shut down.

Police are also prepared to close an extra block around the lake if necessary.

Organizers for the memorial at Lake Eola in downtown Orlando have asked participants to bring flowers, candles and messages of peace.
