Electricity

Metro has 40 diesel-electric hybrid buses. Using a combination of fuels, Metro gets the best each has to offer. The result is a 30% increase in gas mileage and a 90% decrease in particle and carbon monoxide waste. Hybrids also required less maintenance than traditional buses.

Of course, Metro Rail runs on 100% electricity. A portion of which comes from Niagara Falls making it the most environmentally friendly form of motorized transportation you can use.



Compressed Natural Gas

Natural gas burns the best of all the fossil fuels, leaving mostly carbon dioxide and water behind – just like us. It produces less pollution and particulate matter than gasoline.
