VTA's Social Media Contest Campaign

Have you ever heard people say they don't ride public transit because it doesn't go where they want to go? So have we. We wanted to change that perception.

VTA's "Favorite ___ Near VTA" campaigns were designed to leverage social media virality generated by current riders to reach high-potential riders with credible, authentic messages. We wanted to demonstrate in simple terms how rich a transit lifestyle can be, while also building stronger relationships with our frequent rider-advocates.

For a shoestring budget of only \$250-\$500 per campaign for targeted social media ads, we achieved 384,881 impressions, 7,059 engagements, and a solid 1.8% engagement rate.

Harder to measure are the enthusiasm, emotional resonance, and positive brand-building the campaign generated. People really got into it, and they loved the campaign art.


We plan more campaigns like these in the future, based on suggestions from riders of course. Next on the horizon is to discover "VTA riders' favorite boba tea."









Pho History

Pho is considered the national dish of Vietnam. It's believed to have originated from villages in northern Vietnam and was popularized during the French colonial period in the late 19th century.

Its popularity spread to South Vietnam in the 1950s, where its flavors and preparation evolved. The dish was later exported worldwide after 1975 due to Vietnamese migrations, and has since evolved further with adaptations as pho restaurants opened in the United States, Europe, other Asian countries, and around the world.

San Jose has the largest Vietnamese population of any city outside of Vietnam, and Milpitas has a sizeable Vietnamese population as well.

As a result, we have an abundance of great pho restaurants to choose from.

Popular Ingredients

If you're new to pho, here are some insights into the popular ingredients you'll encounter, provided by our own resident pho-natics.

Pho always uses white rice noodles. You can choose wide or narrow.

The secret to a great bowl of pho is in the broth. The broth is usually either beef-based (pho bo) or chicken-based (pho ga). There are also vegetarian options in some restaurants.

The secret is cooking the broth with bones, herbs and spices in big pots for many hours. Some of the common spices are star anise, rock sugar, lemon grass, coriander pods, cloves, cinnamon sticks, fennel, cardamom, fish sauce, and white onions.







