

HOW TO RIDE

IN THE MORNING

- 1. Go to the nearest bus stop along the route closest to your home Remember that all intersections along the bus route are bus stops.
- 2. Until you learn when the bus will arrive at your stop, allow yourself plenty of time.
- If you're not sure you have the right bus, just ask the driver.
- 4. The bus will pull into the school to let you off in the same location as the yellow school buses.

AFTER SCHOOL

- Most of the buses will arrive in front of the schools at dismissal time.
- 2. Check the destination sign on the front or side of the bus before you get on. Again, if you're not sure you have the right bus, just ask the driver.
- **3.** About a block before you want to get off the bus, press the strip which is located between the windows.
- 4. When you get off the bus, step to the curb and wait for the bus to leave.

Northside Middle School students will be required to change buses at the transfer station in the morning and after school. Staff and Security will be available to ensure safe transfers.

MITS detours many of its bus routes to provide transportation to the schools before and after school. Most students only ride about 15 minutes. Use the MITS Time app or Student Ride Guide to locate the bus nearest your home, or call MITS at (765) 289-MITS. There's also an automated trip planner on the website at www.mitsbus.org.

Ride Free with School ID

Students ride free at all times with a valid school identification card. The bus drivers typically don't need to see ID cards when students are traveling to and from school. However, older students should have their ID ready to show the drivers when they are using the buses at other times, like weekends or evenings.

Do not walk around the MITS bus to cross the street. Other traffic does not stop.
