When her husband lost his sight, Mary Massad became the primary driver in her household. She would drive him to his eye doctor in Oklahoma City, a four-hour round trip from their home in Frederick. "It's like having my personal chauffeur. I don't have to drive, I don't have to worry about parking, I don't pay the tolls, it's just perfect for me."
